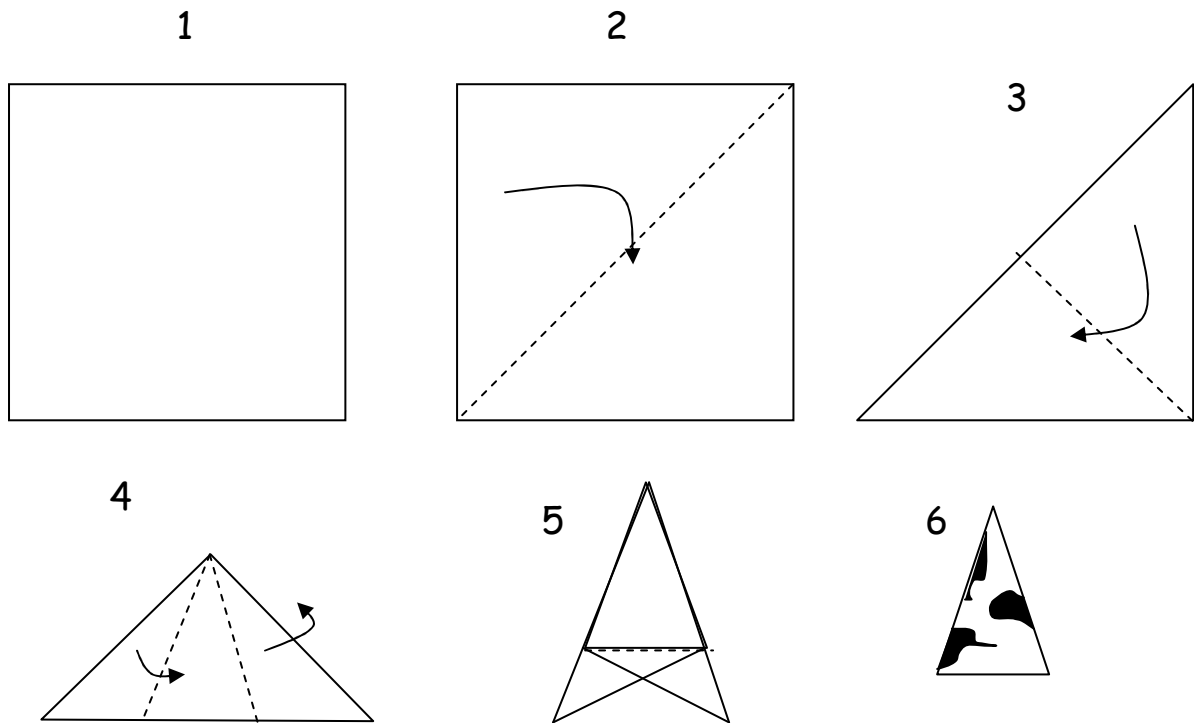

How to Make Paper Snowflakes



Instructions:

- 1 You need a square piece of paper,
- 2 Fold it in half diagonally (like in the picture number 2),
- 3 Now you have a triangle. Fold it in half diagonally as well (like in the picture number 3),
- 4 Now fold the triangle in thirds. One side goes to the front, the other to the back (shown in the picture number 4),
- 5 Trim the extra piece of paper off the end of your small triangle (the dotted line in the picture number 5 shows where to cut),
- 6 It's time to design your snowflake. Cut some fun shapes around the outside of the triangle - circles, squares or anything you like (the black spots in the picture number 6 shows an example of what can be cut out). Show your creativity and don't be afraid to experiment!
- 7 Now the most exciting part! Unfold your paper and look at your beautiful and unique snowflake!
- 8 Your snowflake is now ready. Hang it in your window or anywhere you like to see it snowing!
